





3 Values of CHHRGE:

1. Community-driven approach

2. People-centered decision making

3. Interprofessional collaboration



Goals of CHHRGE

Initial Focus: Prevention

- Reduce risk of spread of COVID-19 among homeless residents and the staff providing care
- Isolate those with symptoms of COVID-19, especially those at highest mortality risk
- Provide supplemental support for agencies serving the homeless and vulnerably housed
- Sustain basic **medical and mental health services** for the homeless population

Current Focus: Sustainability & Improvement

- Obtain COVID-19 nose cultures quickly when outbreaks occur
- Isolate those with confirmed COVID-19 and support their recovery address complex psychosocial and medical needs
- Serve as a clearinghouse for information, support, and problem-solving








CHHRGE Initiatives

- □ COVID-19 **Isolation Center** A Safe Haven
- **Expedited Housing** Chicago Continuum of Care
- □ COVID-19 screening, testing, and vaccinations
- Advocacy for funding from the CARES Act, expansion of eviction moratorium, and shelter vaccination priority
- Treatment not Trauma


